

Vagelis Papakonstantinou is a <u>Professor on Personal Data Protection Law</u> at the <u>Faculty of Law & Criminology</u> of the Free University of Brussels (<u>VUB, Vrije Universiteit Brussel</u>), focusing also on Cybersecurity, Intellectual Property, and the broader topic of technology regulation.
