



CALL OF INTEREST

In the context of the implementation of the Basic Education Program, the Hellenic Industrial Property Academy (HIPA), an independent unit of the Hellenic Organisation of Industrial Property (O.B.I.), invites interested scientists to submit a nomination file for being selected as tutors in the fields of patent theory and practical industrial property applications. Candidates for the basic education program must belong to one of the following categories:

- a) Certified Patent Attorneys of a Member State of the European Union, holders of the relevant title, with proven acquired experience of at least five (5) years in the field of industrial property, or
- b) Individuals showing expertise in the field of intellectual property, or economics, or technological innovation studies and having minimum relevant experience of at least five (5) years, or
- c) Professors of Greek or foreign Universities, without prejudice to any form of incompatibility they may have.

The hourly compensation of tutors is €100 (one hundred euros) plus VAT (if applicable), as determined by decision of the Board of Directors of HIPA.

Those interested are invited to email their nomination file in the PDF form to the HIPA address (academy@obi.gr). Each nomination file should include a letter of interest and curriculum vitae (in Greek or English). In the case of selection of a candidate, the latter will be asked to provide supporting documents/justifications certifying that the candidate belongs, at least, in one of the categories (from a' to c') mentioned herein.

HIPA reserves the right to cancel, suspend, modify, or postpone this process without prior notice, as well as to stop negotiations or conversations at any point in time, without any liability towards the participants and/or third parties.

Important Dates

Electronic nomination files must be received by the HIPA Secretariat by December 16, 2022, at 15:00p.m (Central European Time). Nominations received after this date will not be considered. The final selection will be made by the Board of Directors of HIPA and the results will be announced to the successful candidates until January 16, 2023.

An indicative start date for the basic training program is February 20, 2023.
